- Q' 5. One of Nancy's constant companions suffers from lingering paranoia after being drugged in, *The Clue of the Velvet Mask*. Who is it? *A: George Fayne*
- Q' 6. This attractive, much younger sister of Carson Drew, provides lodging and chaperone services in New York for Nancy and her friends. What is her name?

 A: Eloise Drew

- Q' 7. The original Helen Corning dates a fraternity brother of Ned's, but later in the original series, this young man prefers George Fayne. What is his name? A: Buck Rodman
- Q' 8. This cousin of Nancy's lives in Virginia, and her neighborhood provides a setting for mystery. What is her name? *A: Susan Carr* BONUS: Name the book where Nancy pays a visit. A: *The Hidden Window Mystery*
- Q' 9. Nancy's grandmother lives in stately Scotland, and has a famous tartan associated with her last name. *A: Lady Douglas* BONUS: What mystery does Nancy solve for her grandmother? *A: A missing diamond and topaz brooch*
- Q' 10. This antique dealer appears in two sequential volumes, and helps Nancy determine the value of imported and antique items. What is his name? *A: Mr. Faber* BONUS: What volumes include this character? *A: Jewel Box & Old Attic GENIUS*: This character is modeled after what famous Slavic artisans? *A: Faberge family*
